If you are unable to timely return your voted absentee or mail-in ballot, you may only vote a provisional ballot at your polling place on election day unless (1) you surrender to the judge of elections your absentee or mail-in ballot and envelope containing the declaration of the elector in order that the ballot and declaration may be spoiled; and (2) you sign at your polling place a statement subject to the penalties under 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities) that you have not cast your ballot and have returned it to your polling place, in which case you will be permitted to vote by regular ballot at your polling place.
5. If you make a mistake, ask Judge for a new ballot.




